Subject: Western Green Announces Changes in Operational Locations

Due to changes in the current market, and with our commitment to keeping a strong regional manufacturing business model, Western Green announces the closing of its manufacturing plant in Campbell, Texas. Effective immediately we are ceasing operations and production of all erosion and sediment control product lines from this location but will continue to ship finished good products from the facility as inventory holds.

The Campbell facility opened in 2018 with the intent of better serving our regional distribution partners, after losing the Mancos, CO facility to a catastrophic fire in May 2017. While we tried our best to keep this location on-line, we currently see no path forward for growth and profitability. We are grateful for all the efforts put forth in Campbell, Texas plant, and thank you for your support and understanding regarding this decision. We believe this action is necessary and will enhance our company's strength and focus moving forward.

Our McPherson, Kansas facility opened in 2019 and is also well positioned to serve the markets affected by this decision. Additionally, we have further expansion plans in place for McPherson, KS and remain invested in our five additional manufacturing and stocking locations. Western Green does not foresee any delays in production or impacts on customer serviceability as a result of this change. We will work to provide a smooth transition for our customers.
